3-on-3 basketball is a short, sharp game played on a half court: Gisborne Basketball Club, Riddells Creek Junior Mixed Basketball Association, Riddells Creek Basketball Club, Woodend Hawks and Kyneton Basketball Association and have come together to run a 3 on 3 competition!

3x3 Rules of the Game

	A regular 3x3 court playing surface is 15m (width) x 11m (length) –
Team roster	4 players 3 + 1 substitute (at 5min mark)
Referee(s)	1 (2 to be used for Grand Final)
Scoring	1 point and 2 points, if scored behind the short 3pt line
Game duration & Score limit	1 x 10 minutes, playing time
Overtime	Possession alternates from Initial Possession. First team to score two (2) points wins the game
Free throw(s) following a shooting foul	1 free throw, 2 free throws, if foul committed behind the arc
Foul limit per team	6 team fouls Note: there are no Personal Fouls in 3x3
Penalty for team fouls 7, 8 and 9	2 free throws
Possession following a successful goal	Defence possession Right underneath the hoop, Ball to be dribbled or passed to a player behind the arc, Defensive team not allowed to play for the ball inside the "no-charge semicircle" area underneath the basket
Substitutions	In dead ball situations, prior to check ball. The substitution can enter the game after their teammate steps off the court and establishes a physical contact with the player behind the side/ end line. Substitutions require no action from the referee or table officials.
